Call to order: Jones called to order 7:00pm

Guest: Many township residents from Hanover Road also Bob Griffis and Shawn
Surgue from Jackson County Road Commission.

Unfinished Business: Motion made by Riske supported by Dawson to pay
estimated bills and payroll for June as presented.

New Business: Reason for this meeting was to discuss possible solutions for road
repairs on Hanover Road west of Pulaski Road, with Jackson
Department of Transportation and any other Township business.

* Griffis explained that the primary roads were 100% of Counties to
repair. Other roads were split 50% County and 50% other sources.
0% taxes goes into roads. 1998 was the last increase in road
funding.

* County has the authority to declare roads no longer reasonably
safe, and repairs as they see fit. As of now Hanover is still
reasonably safe so we have a short period of time to decide how

we want to repair it.

* There were some options:

1.) Crush back to gravel which the county at this time would pay
100% to have it done.

2.) Repaving it which would cost several thousands of dollars.

Public Discussion: Several residents asked questions and gave their opinions .

Board Members Comments: Riske tried to explain what the road would be like if
put back to gravel.

* It was decided to get more information and figure out financially
what the township could do.
