- \* Motion made by Jones to purchase new job duty books for Township Board. Supported by Dawson. Carried.
- \* Riske has been working on a Federal Grant for payroll reimbursement for the firemen. The grant would be for \$1,448.48.

**COMMISSION REPORT:** Dan Riley, Fire Chief gave Commissions Report. Total runs for June 2020, 11; Vehicle fire, 1; Auto Aid, Concord-3, Hanover-1, Spring Arbor 1. Total active, 15 and 3 Cadets.

**BUSINESS:** Motion made by Runyon supported by Dawson to put Maxwell Ley on the Fire Department pending his physical and paperwork being done. Carried.

- \* Maxwell has been a firefighter for Hanover Fire Department for over a year and has completed fire one and two and MFR. Background check was done, finding no issues.

**BILLS:** Motion made by Jones supported by Riske to pay July, 2020 bills as presented for \$34,193.66, plus Citgo. Carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Dean Claucherty was told by Jones to discuss his problem regarding his land at the Board of Review.

**BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS:** Jones let the residents know that the tire cleanup went well and will keep the trailer all week for everyone to put more tires in it. He also thanked Jeremy Bush, Ralph Riley, Bill Haire, and Aaron Losey for helping with the tire cleanup.

- \* Haire talked about getting a new tape recorder for the Board meetings.
- \* Jones talked about people leaving trash where they put their kayaks in.
