BRIEF PUBLIC COMMENTS: * Fire Chief Mosher would like to reword Section 5-1-1 & 5-2-2 in the policy where it states (must) and replace it with (recommend). Tabled until we have a contract developed.

- * State regulation is that a Fire Department has at least 6-MFR and 6- Firefighters.
- * If the person is only MFR or FF you are considered a Trainee at the pay of \$12.00. If the person is both the pay is \$15.00.
- * For the Fire Dept. to pay for class fees the person needs to sign a contract. Date of hire, 24 month active at 10% of runs. MFR cost \$500.00. Firefighter I & II cost \$475.00
- * Earl Poleski: Road Commission is responsible for our roads. He will see to it that it meets our satisfaction.
- * Dates of drills: 3-16 Emergency Exercise drill
3-24 Tornado drill
6-19 AG Emergency drill
- * Health Dept. has Covid-19 Vaccines. 46,000 doses in Jackson County, 42,000 used. Johnson/Johnson vaccines is only 1 shot.

Total taxes paid: \$ 1,964,281.10
Delinquent taxes: \$12,910.86

Real property taxes will be reimbursed by the County in May.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: MRE- revenue: The State has the amount of \$ 9,968,469.92 in Marihuana revenue. The state has dispersed the money to the Townships. Pulaski Township received \$28,001.00 from the Marihuana revenue for 2020. It has been put in the General Funds to be used.

- * Peter talked about the roads in Pulaski Township stating the County of Jackson get 20% of Revenue from his two stores. Also one way Township could make money for things we need done is the Fire Department needs to charge for inspections, Inspections are done twice a year.
- * Fire Chief Lloyd Mosher stated Engine 1 went to its first fire and things went well.
